PRECAUTIONARY BOIL ORDER NOTICE

TO: Residents located in Marina Village, Marina Manor, Grande Quay, Grouper Hole Drive, Peekins Cove Drive, and all businesses in the Boca Grande Resort complex, Uncle Henry's Marina, and Kappy's Market.

Due to an emergency water main repair in your area, your water has been turned off.

Due to the difficulty of the repair, your water may be off for several hours.

Therefore, as a precaution, we advise that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

This "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until a Bacteriological Survey (two consecutive days' of water samples) shows that the water is safe to drink. The earliest we can expect those results is Thursday, October 15, around noon.
